Boone County Extension Homemakers Association Freda Carlin Scholarship

A scholarship fund was established in 2021 by the Carlin Family in honor and appreciation of Freda Carlin. Freda was an active, long-time member of Boone County Extension Homemakers Association. Always ready with a helping hand, Freda loved bringing people together. Freda served her community through many volunteer leadership roles and lived the example of a caring neighbor, dedicated to helping those in need through service and deed. Her own legacy of giving, rebuffing the spotlight, and rolling up her sleeves to make a difference, are the foundation for this scholarship.

The Carlin Family is pleased to offer a scholarship for up to \$1,000 based on the following rules and regulations.

- The scholarship may be used for full-time or part-time students, selected to attend any college or accredited higher education undergraduate program in Kentucky (i.e. university, college, trade, or technical school).
- Individuals under the age of 24 years are encouraged to apply.
- The scholarship recipient is selected based on good character, community engagement and focus on volunteer activities. A background with youth development programs (4-H, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, etc.) will be considered.
- Appropriate grammar and punctuation will be considered.
- The scholarship is renewable one time. Previous scholarship winners who wish to reapply are not required to complete the initial application but must supply an official copy of their transcript and a one-page letter describing what higher education has meant to them during the last year.
- The scholarship winner will be invited to attend the Annual Meeting of the Boone County Extension Homemakers Association on Saturday, May 18, 2024, to be recognized as a scholarship recipient.
- The recipient will be required to write and mail thank-you notes to members of the Carlin Family and the Boone County Extension Homemakers Association (contact information will be provided).
- The scholarship application form is three pages and follows this description. If needed, applications can be up to four pages.

- Scholarships will be judged according to the following criteria:

Community Service and Activities	30 Points
Financial Need	25 Points
Overall Impression	20 Points
Scholastic Achievement	15 Points
Leadership	10 Points
- Please note that handwritten applications will not be considered. The complete application packet must include:
 1. Application form;
 2. Official transcript of most current coursework and grades; and
 3. Two (2) letters of reference from people who can comment on the applicant but are not related to the applicant.
 4. Copy of acceptance letter from the institution.

NO CHECKS WILL BE ISSUED UNTIL CONFIRMATION OF ENROLLMENT IS RECEIVED FROM THE INSTITUTION. ALL INFORMATION WILL REMAIN CONFIDENTIAL.
